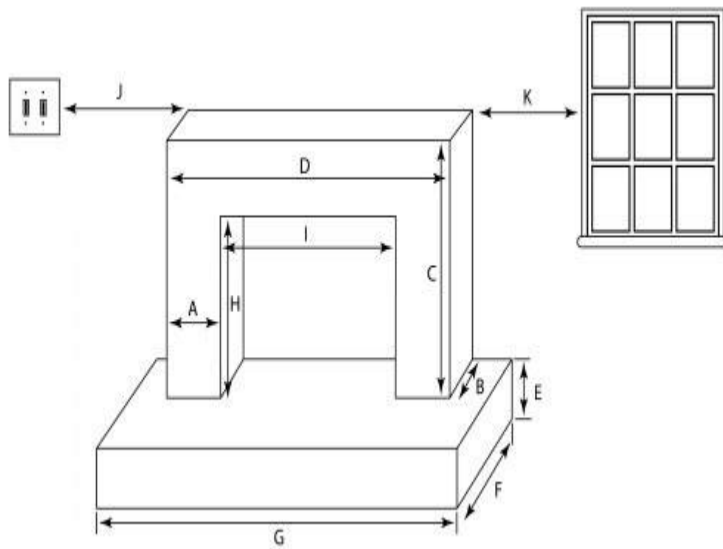


FOCAL POINT
